## Priorities 2019

ClubGRANTS funding is open to not-for-profit incorporated associations or groups auspiced by a not-for-profit incorporated organisation. ClubGRANTS does not support private enterprise.

Campbelltown ClubGrants considers any project delivered within the Campbelltown LGA which helps improve the general wellbeing of the local community but gives priority to projects falling under the following priorities:

Community Welfare and Social Services	CALD & Aboriginal Community Diversity Aboriginal Families Children aged 0-3
Community Development	Place based community enhancement projects
Employment Assistance Activities	Pathways for young people –employment, cultural diversity, education
Community Health Services	Childhood Obesity
Projects improving the living standards of the low income and disadvantaged people	Young Parents – under 20
