Information stalls must provide a child or family related activity/hand out to participants i.e. craft, colouring, or free resources.

Obligations of Stall Holders

Must arrive and set up within the designated time, all vehicles are to be moved from set up area before 9.00am
Responsible for their stall/tent which must always be supervised. Tharawal LALC takes no responsibility for overseeing this
Must ensure that all equipment used for the activities is safe and meets relevant requirements: *The stall must be installed to the appropriate standards for safety (i.e. manufacture standards) *Electricity connections – leads must be tagged and water proof and away from public traffic area (inaccessible to children) *Amusement devices must comply with minimum requirements of maintenance, operation and Method of installation, own generator to be supplied.
Must pack up at the agreed/designated time to ensure there is no obstruction or inconvenience To the public or other participants.
Must ensure the area is left clean without any damage or risk to the public or other participants. Rubbish must be removed and placed in bin.
